

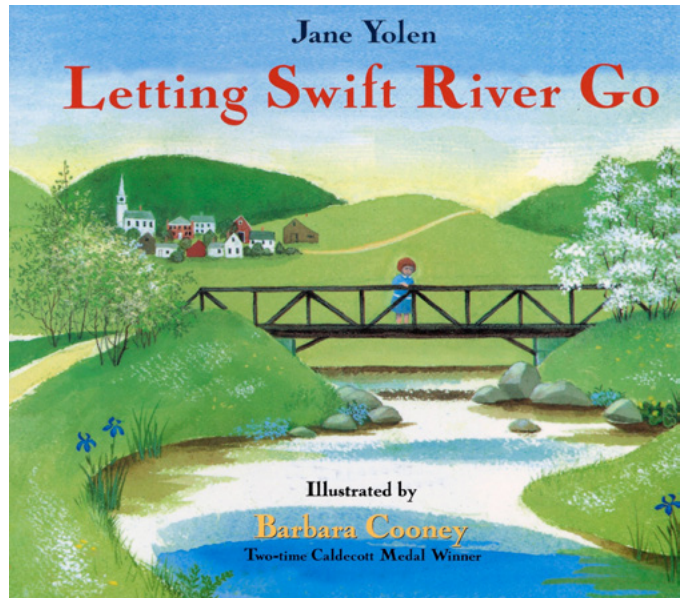
An Experience I'll Never Forget
