Through the humanities, we build communities, entertain challenging topics, and engage all people in New Hampshire through public programming and grant opportunities for eligible nonprofits.

We empower partners to deliver programs that spark conversations and curiosity and inspire a life of learning.

We provided wide-ranging, thought-provoking, and high-quality humanities-based programs that connect people across New Hampshire to culture, history, places, ideas, and each other.

We connect people with ideas through free public events, literacy programs, and grantmaking.

An independent, statewide nonprofit, NHH made possible last year 1,206 free public programs reaching 33,470 residents in partnership in 181 communities with 414 organizations to engage all citizens, regardless of their age or educational level.

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
