### *New Humanities to Go Presentation*

Please complete the New HTG Presentation form and submit the required materials (listed below) to NHH by April 30, 2024.

The information you provide will be reviewed by NHH staff and sent to the NHH Program Committee for review. They will evaluate the proposed presentation and make a recommendation to NHH regarding its addition to the HTG catalogue.

### Evaluation Criteria

**Reviewers will consider the following criteria when evaluating the proposed presentation:**

- The degree to which the program draws on at least one humanities discipline and uses concepts and methods from the humanities.
- The degree to which the presentation has a clear focus and organization that will allow the audience to learn about the topic.
- The degree to which the presentation is grounded in substantive research and draws upon current, respected scholarship.
- The degree to which the presenter articulates clear learning goals for the program and has structured the program in such a way to achieve these learning goals.
- The degree to which the presenter is qualified to speak on the proposed topic and can provide an informative and engaging presentation that is appropriate for a general audience.
- The degree to which the program's subject will interest HTG audiences.
- The degree to which the program would expand the current HTG catalog by drawing on a field or covering a topic that is not already represented and grow the reach or appeal of HTG to appeal to broader audience.

## Required Materials

**Please provide the following to NHH.**

- ❖ A completed New HTG Presentation form for each proposed program (limit is two proposed programs).
- ❖ A copy of your CV.
- ❖ OPTIONAL: A 5–7-minute sample video recording that demonstrates your presentation style. We encourage samples of the proposed presentation, including recordings, but this is not required. You could also submit a selection from a previously recorded presentation (Zoom or another taping) that would best highlight your abilities as an HTG presenter.

**Submit all materials to NHH by April 30, 2024.**

3. Review and submit your form by April 30, 2024. If you are submitting more than one new presentation, you must complete this form for every program you propose.
